

UKTDA Championship 2020 & Woodland Challenge
to be held on Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th March 2020
At Walford Village Hall, Walford, Ross-On-Wye, HR9 5QS

Saturday 14th March 2020

Level 4 Championship. - Open to dogs that have qualified Level 4, either Wilderness Pursuit or Mixed Terrain and hold the UKTDA Qualified Expert Tracking Dog title. Tracks will be marked by two assessors. The marks given by each assessor will be combined to determine the UKTDA Champion (winner) and the subsequent placings. In the event of a tie, there will be a run-off track to decide the winner.

Sunday 15th March 2020

Level 4 Assessments - For dogs that hold the UKTDA Qualified Expert Tracking Dog title but have not achieved a Level 4.

Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th March 2020

Woodland Challenge - Open to all dogs that have a UKTDA qualification at Level 1 or above, but do not hold the UKTDA Qualified Expert Tracking Dog title. This competition will comprise a track of approximately 500 yards through woodland, on which three articles will be placed along the track. The track will be marked out of 100 by a single assessor. Additional marks are allocated for each article found (maximum of 10 marks per article).

The Woodland Challenge does not count towards a normal assessment.
